

From Halifax or Dartmouth, NS:

Get yourself to the 8-laner that passes the Mic Mac Mall – heading away from Halifax and away from the harbour.

As you are just getting past the Mic Mac Mall turn-off, chose from the 3 or 4 large, green directional signs up above – you want to chose one of the two lanes that are furthest to your left – the ones that take you toward **Portland Street and Eastern Passage**.

After you pass under a green metal pedestrian walkway, start your transfer to the right hand lane (unless already there). Pass up on the first right hand turn off. Take the 2nd, which starts under the underpass (which is Portland Street above you). That turn off is a continual turn to the right until you merge with Portland Street traffic.

As you proceed over that overpass, start to move into the middle lane or lanes. As you approach the lights downgrade at Woodlawn Road, you want the 2nd or 3rd lane from the right hand side of the road.

Next set of lights go straight. You will see a car dealership or two. Next set of lights is at the entrance to Portland Estates and the bottom of “Heartbreak Hill” (see the history of Cole Harbour).

Next set of lights is near the top of that hill. Next set of lights is at the Metro Transit “Link” bus launch pad area. By now, Portland Street has morphed into Cole Harbour Road (entering the former County of Halifax).

Next set of lights is at the junction with Caldwell Road – stay the course. Next set of lights is just past the Esso station. Now you should be ensuring that you are in the right hand lane – only one set of lights to go !

After next set of lights (by Kentucky Fried Chicken)...you want to start to watch for Village Plaza...it's the 2nd driveway on your right after the lights. If you miss that one, use the 3rd driveway on your right – at Chris Brothers.
